Mt 5:14 "You are the light of the world. . .


<u>Isa 60:1</u> Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the LORD is risen upon you.

<u>Is 53:12</u> (Christ) made intercession for the transgressors. <u>Lk 23:34</u> (on the cross) J prayed: Father forgive them, they know not what they do. Num 16:46-48 So Moses said to Aaron, "Take a censer and *put fire in it from the altar*, put *incense* on it. So he put in the incense and made atonement for the people. 48 And he stood between the dead and the living;







- Is. 6:4-8... the house was filled with smoke.
- 5 So I said: "Woe is me, for I am undone! Because I am a man of unclean lips. . .
- 6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a *live coal* which he had taken with the tongs from the altar.
- 7 And he touched my mouth with it, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, And your sin purged."
- 8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me."

Gen 22:12-14 . . . you have not withheld your son, *your only son,* from Me." 13 Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind him was a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son.

14 And Abraham called the name of the place, The-LORD - Will-Provide (*YHWH Yireh*).

Heb 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac . . .
