Acts 16:22-25 . . . *tore off their clothes* and commanded them to be *beaten with rods*.<sup>23</sup> And when they had laid many stripes on them, they threw them into *prison*, commanding the jailer to keep them securely.<sup>24</sup> Having received such a charge, he put them into the *inner prison* and fastened their feet in the *stocks*.<sup>25</sup> But at midnight Paul and Silas were *praying* and *singing* hymns *to God* . . .

Rev 3:8 I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have *a little strength*, have kept My word, and have not denied My name.

You have *a little strength*

Jn 4:23-24 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the *true worshipers* will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is *seeking* such to worship Him. <sup>24</sup> God is Spirit, and those who worship Him *must* worship in *spirit and truth*."

Ps 95:6 Oh come, let us *worship and bow down*

Phil 3:3 *we are the circumcision,  
who worship God in the Spirit*

*Not just lips, but heart.*

Matt 15:8 "These people draw near to Me with their *mouth*, And honor Me with their *lips*, But their *heart* is far from Me.

*Not just heart – lips too.*

You have *a little strength* to:

Heb 13:15 . . . offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our *lips*. . .

You have a *little* strength to:

*Sing to His Name*

Ps 30:4 *Sing* praise to the LORD, you saints of His, And give thanks at the remembrance of *His holy name*.

Ps 68:4 *Sing* to God, sing praises to His *name*. . .

*Worship with the WORD*

Ps 138:1-2 I will praise You with my whole *heart*; Before the gods I will *sing praises* to *You*. 2 I will *worship* toward Your holy temple, And praise Your name For Your lovingkindness and Your truth; For You have *magnified Your word* above all Your name.

Ps 119:160 The entirety of Your word is truth. . .

Col 2:6 . . . as you received Christ Jesus, so  
walk you in Him.

2Cor 4:3-4 But even if our gospel is veiled, it is  
veiled to those who are perishing, 4 whose minds  
the god of this age has blinded. . .

2Cor 3:15-17 . . . when Moses is read, a veil lies on their  
heart, 16 Nevertheless when one *turns to the Lord*, the veil  
is taken away, 17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the  
Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.



You have a *little* strength to:

*Worship Him For Everything He Does & With Everything We Have*

Ps 89:1 I will sing of the *mercies* of the LORD forever;

Ps 150 Praise the LORD! Praise God in His sanctuary; Praise Him in His mighty firmament!

2 Praise Him *for His mighty acts*; Praise Him according to *His excellent greatness*!

3 Praise Him with the sound of the *trumpet*; Praise Him with the *lute* and *harp*!

4 Praise Him with the *timbrel* and *dance*; Praise Him with *stringed* instruments and *flutes*!

5 Praise Him with *loud cymbals*; Praise Him with clashing cymbals!

6 Let *everything that has breath* praise the LORD. Praise the LORD!

For His lovingkindness:

Ps 63:3-4 *Because Your lovingkindness is better than life*, My *lips* shall praise You.

4 Thus I will bless You while I live; *I will lift up my hands* in Your name.

Ps 134:2 *Lift up your hands* in the sanctuary, And bless the LORD.

*You have a little strength to:*

*Worship in Spirit and in **TRUTH***

*You have a little strength to:*

*Worship in **SPIRIT** and in Truth*

2Chron 20:18 . . . all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem bowed before the LORD, *worshiping* the LORD.

v. 21. . . he appointed those who should *sing to the LORD*, and who should *praise the beauty of holiness*, as they went out before the army and were saying: "*Praise the LORD, For His mercy endures forever.*"

v. 22 . . . *when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushes* against the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; and they were defeated.

Ps 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul; And all  
that is within me, bless His holy name!
