<u>Rom 12:3</u> For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, *not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think*, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a *measure of faith*. Rom 12:4-6 . . . all the members do not have the same function. . .

6 Having then gifts differing *according to the grace that is given to us*, let us use them:

Rom 12:8 . . . he who *gives*, with liberality . . .

Rom 12:8 . . . he who *leads*, with diligence . . .

<u>Rom 12:8</u> . . . he who shows *mercy*, with cheerfulness.

<u>Eph 4:32</u> forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. <u>Is. 30:18</u> He is waiting to be gracious to you.

<u>Col 3:13</u> bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do.

Rom 12:10 . . . In honor giving preference to one another. . .

Rom 12:11 . . . FERVENT IN SPIRIT...

Rom 12:12 . . . continuing steadfastly in *prayer*

14 . . . bless and *do not curse*.

16 Be of the *same mind* toward one another.

. . . Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.

17 Repay no one evil for evil.

18 as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all. . .

<u>19</u>... do not avenge yourselves...

<u>1Cor 12:21</u> And the eye *cannot say* to the hand, "*I have no need of you*"...

25 . . . *should be no schism* in the body. . .

<u>26</u>... if one member suffers, **all** the members suffer with it...

... if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it...

<u>1Cor 13:5</u> *does not behave rudely. . .*

. . . is not provoked. . .

keeps no record of wrongs

<u>James 3:9</u> With it [*the tongue*] we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God.

<u>17</u> But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, *willing to yield*, full of *mercy* and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy.

18 Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who *make peace*.

<u>10</u> Out of the same *mouth* proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, *these things ought not to be so*.

<u>James 3:11</u> Does a spring send forth fresh water and bitter from the same opening? 12 . . . no spring yields both salt water and fresh.
