Heb 4:11-16 Let us therefore be diligent to enter that *rest*, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience. **12** For the *word of God* is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. **13** And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

Heb 4:11-16 cont.

14 Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us *hold fast* our confession. **15** For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with *our weaknesses*

but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin

16 Let us therefore come *boldly* to the *throne of grace*, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

1Pet 1:23-2:1 having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the *word* of God which *lives* and abides forever

24 because "All flesh is as grass, And all the *glory of man* as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, And its flower falls away, **25** *But the word* of the LORD endures forever."

Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you.

2 Therefore, *laying aside* all malice, all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and all evil speaking

Eph 3:11-12 according to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord, **12** in whom we have ***boldness*** and *access* with confidence through faith in Him.

Heb 10:11-23 And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins.

12 But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, *sat down* at the right hand of God,

13 from that time *waiting* till His enemies are made His footstool

14 For by one offering He *has perfected* forever those who are *being* sanctified.

18 Now where there is remission of these, *there is no longer an offering for sin.*

19 Therefore, brethren, having *boldness* to enter *the Holiest by the blood* of Jesus,

22 let us *draw near* with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our *hearts sprinkled* from an *evil conscience* and our bodies washed with pure water.

23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for *He* who promised is *faithful*.

30 But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God — and righteousness and sanctification and redemption —

"He who glories, let him glory in the LORD ."
